Units that need to pay Mandatory Funds are: McMechen Unit #5 (only ordered poppies), Mannington Unit #40, Parkersburg Unit #104, (only ordered poppies), Bluefield Unit #9, Lewisburg Unit #69, Richwood Unit #97, (owes Bonding \$5.00), Franklin Unit #30. Charles Town Unit #102.

Processing Membership: Make sure your membership is into Department Headquarters by the 15th to be counted for Targets.

Membership: All applications must have signature of a Post Officer and if they are a Junior member a Birthdate. **Unit Membership Chairman should** check each application to make sure it is filled out completely including City, Post #, State and zip code. If eligibility is under a Veteran living all information must be filled out before processing into Department Head**quarters**. If a veteran is living they must hold membership in The American Legion. All unfinished applications will be returned this year. Please check the Birthdates of your Juniors renewing this year. If they will turn 18 years old by December 31, 2014 they are considered a Senior Member. **Remember:** if a Woman Veteran joins the Auxiliary under herself you must

CALL FOR NINETY-THIRD ANNUAL DEPARTMENT CONVENTION OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY DEPARTMENT OF WEST VIRGINIA, INC.

The Ninety-Third Department Convention of the American Legion Auxiliary is hereby called and, in conformity with Article IX, Section 1 of the Department Constitution and Bylaws which provides, "That the Department Convention be held annually concurrent with the convention of The American Legion, Department of West Virginia". The Convention will meet in Morgantown Wes Virginia on July 9, 10, 11, 2015 at the Ramada Inn.

PURPOSE

The Convention is called for the purpose of electing officers for the ensuing year, amending the Department Constitution, receiving reports of Department Officers and Chairmen, and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before it.

REPRESENTATIVES

Representation at the Convention shall by Units. Each Unit shall be entitled to two delegates, and one additional delegate for each fifty (50) members or a major fraction thereof, whose dues have been paid and received by the Department Headquarters on month prior to the Convention for which they were elected. Each delegate shall be entitled to one vote. **No Unit unpresented shall have a proxy vote.** The elective officers, all Past Department Presidents in good standing shall be delegates-at-large to the Department Convention, with vote to be exercised with their Units, provided said officers are present at the Convention.

ALTERNATES

Each Unit is entitled to one alternate for each delegate. The alternate will have power to vote **ONLY** in the absence of the regular delegate.

CREDENTIALS

Membership cards must be presented by delegates and alternates. Certification of the election of the delegates and alternate MUST be mailed to Department Headquarters no less than two weeks prior to the Convention, and SHALL BE accompanied by the Convention fee of \$15.00 for each accredited delegates so certified.
