The purpose of the AEF Committee is to raise funds for and awareness of the AEF, to promote knowledge about the program, to get the information to members about the application process, and to assist member in need.

The AEF provides eligible members with temporary assistance for:

- 1. Financial crisis, to pay for food, shelter and utilities. Funds are not available to settle existing or accumulated debts, or to help with catastrophic illnesses.
- 2. Food and shelter, due to weather-related emergencies and natural disaster.
- 3. Educational training, due to life changes such as death of a spouse, divorce, or separation, necessitating the Auxiliary member to assume the rule of primary source of support for her family.

In each case, as a first course of action, applicants are encouraged to make every effort to secure financial assistance through local, state and federal agencies.


